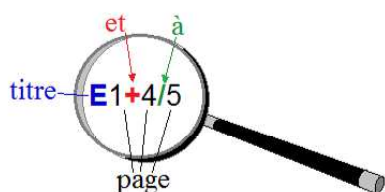

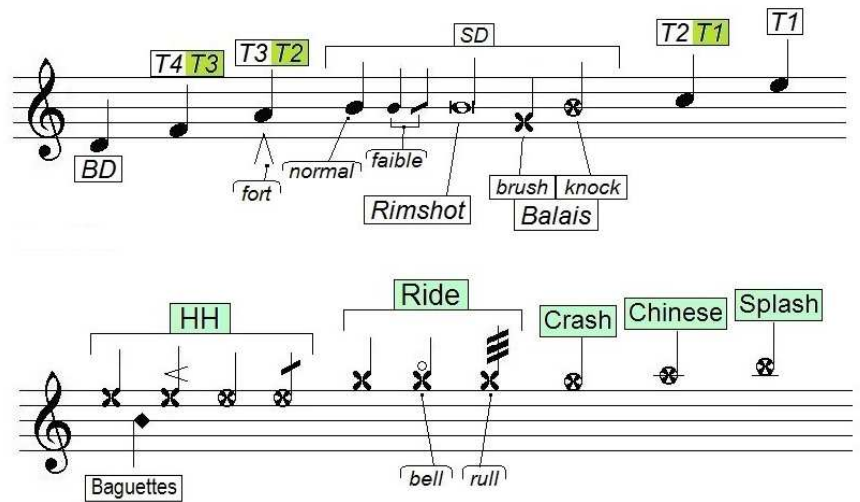
Tic Tac

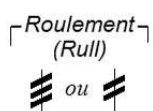
